LCC was founded in 2005, out of concern for increasing forms of violence, especially rape and sexual abuse against women and girls in Liberia during the 14 year civil wars. Although the armed conflicts ended in 2003 rape is still being carried out against women and children. Liberia Crisis Center opened it's first safe shelter in June 2006.
